

Hearing is canceled

A zoning hearing board meeting scheduled for Thursday evening regarding two builders' plans to construct a sewage treatment plant in Tinicum was canceled.

Piper Group and Main Street Development have proposed building about 600 residences in Tinicum and want to construct a sewage treatment plant to service the homes.

The developers formed Tinicum Water and Sewer Group for this purpose and were scheduled to go before the zoning board to challenge the validity of a township ordinance that prohibits stream discharge sewage systems in the Tohickon Creek Watershed District

But the hearing was canceled Thursday afternoon, after Robert Gundlach, attorney for the group, notified the township that a new application will be submitted to the board of supervisors.

A hearing before the supervisors on Monday regarding Main Street's plans to build 192 units in Ottsville is expected to go forward.
